Note: Wet signature exemplars aid diversion investigators with identification of suspected fraudulent written prescriptions found during routine pharmacy inspections. If a controlled substance prescription at a pharmacy is suspected to be fraudulent upon a cursory visual comparison of your signature exemplars, the prescriber will be contacted to confirm the controlled substance prescriptions validity. IMPORTANT NOTE: It is a violation to have a staff member or anyone else sign a controlled substance written prescription on a prescriber's behalf. Controlled substance prescriptions cannot be pre-signed and must be signed and dated on the day the prescription is written.
