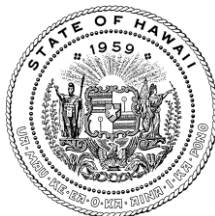

 - 1. The fire chief of each county shall generate compilations and statistical investigations on an annual basis.
 - 2. On January 1 of each year, the fire chief of each county shall transmit records and statistical investigations to the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM). On January 1 of each alternating year, the fire chief of each county shall transmit the inspection record of property that may constitute a fire hazard within their county compiled pursuant to subsection (b)(2) to the OSFM.
 - 3. A county fire chief may request the OSFM to assist with the investigation of a fire as provided in section 132-C.
 - 4. Deletes the requirement for county fire chiefs to annually inspect public schools. The OSFM shall conduct fire and safety inspections at all state facilities at least once a year.
 - 5. The SFC shall coordinate with the SBCC on matters pertaining to fire safety.
