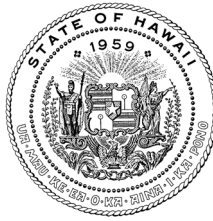

## **NOTICE OF FEDERAL SCHEDULING ACTION**

Section 329-11(d) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") states that if a substance is added, deleted or rescheduled under federal law and notice of the designation is given to the Department of Law Enforcement, then the Department of Law Enforcement shall recommend to the legislature that a corresponding change in Hawaii law be made. The Department of Law Enforcement shall similarly designate the substance as added, deleted, or rescheduled under this chapter, after the expiration of thirty days from publication in the Federal Register of a final order, and this change shall have the effect of law. If a substance is added, deleted, or rescheduled under this subsection, the control shall be temporary and, if the next regular session of the state legislature has not made the corresponding changes in this chapter, the temporary designation of the added, deleted, or rescheduled substance shall be nullified.

The Department of Law Enforcement was given notice via publication in the Federal Register of a final order placing the following substances into the federal controlled substances Schedule I by the United States Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA"). Consequently, the Department of Law Enforcement is making the following temporary designations:

#### **Additions to Section 329-14 subsection (d) Hallucinogens**

- 3-methoxyphencyclidine (1-(1-(3-methoxyphenyl)cyclohexyl)piperidine) (91 FR 13733 03-20-2026)

- Bromazolam (8-bromo-1-methyl-6-phenyl-4H- benzo[f][1,2,4]triazolo[4,3-a][1,4]diazepine). (91 FR 12504 03-13-2026)

#### **Additions to Section 329-14 subsection (g) Cannabinoids**

- Methyl 3,3- dimethyl-2-(1-(pent-4-en-1-yl)-1H- indazole-3-carboxamido)

butanoate (other name: MDMB-4en-PINACA). **(91 FR 21958 04-23-2026)**

- Methyl 2-[[1-(4-fluorobutyl)indole-3-carbonyl]amino]-3,3-dimethyl-butanoate (other names: 4F-MDMB-BUTICA; 4F-MDMB-BICA), including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23359 04-30-2026)**
- N-(1-amino-3,3-dimethyl-1-oxobutan-2-yl)-1-(pent-4-en-1-yl)-1 *H* -indazole-3-carboxamide (other name: ADB-4en-PINACA) including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23359 04-30-2026)**
- ethyl 2-[[1-(5-fluoropentyl)indole-3-carbonyl]amino]-3,3-dimethyl-butanoate (other names: 5F-EDMB-PICA; 5F-EDMB-2201) including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23359 04-30-2026)**
- methyl 2-(1-(4-fluorobenzyl)-1 *H* -indole-3-carboxamido)-3-methyl butanoate (other name: MMB-FUBICA) including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23359 04-30-2026)**
- 5-pentyl-2-(2-phenylpropan-2-yl)pyrido[4,3-*b*]indol-1-one (other names: CUMYL-PEGACLONE; SGT-151), including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23359 04-30-2026)**
- 6,6,9-trimethyl-3-pentyl-6a,7,8,9,10,10a-hexahydro-6H- benzo[*c*]chromen-1-ol (also known as Hexahydrocannabinol) including its salts, isomers, homologs, esters, ethers, fluorinated analogs, alkyl chain variants, and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers, or salts where possible. **(91 FR 23913 05-01-2026)**

### **Explanation of Temporary State Scheduling:**

These federal scheduling actions impose the regulatory controls and the administrative, civil, and criminal sanctions applicable to Schedule I controlled substances on persons who handle (manufacture, distribute, dispense, import, export, engage in research, conduct instructional activities with, or possess) or propose to handle the drug products

listed in this notice.

**In accordance with chapter 329-11(d) of the HRS, the Department of Law Enforcement is temporarily adding the aforementioned substances listed in this notice to Schedule I, in chapter 329-14 of the HRS. This temporary addition imposes the regulatory controls and the administrative, civil, and criminal sanctions applicable to Schedule I controlled substances on persons who handle (manufacture, distribute, dispense, import, export, engage in research, conduct instructional activities with, or possess) or propose to handle the aforementioned substances listed in this notice in the State of Hawaii.**

**The temporary changes contained in this notice take effect immediately.**
